

## **Williamson County Children's Advocacy Center Art Show & Contest Contest Rules and Submission Details**

The show is open to all individuals of Williamson County, 8 years old and older, regardless of race, creed, religion or sexual orientation.

The theme for the show is Courage to Break Down Walls. *Walls* is a metaphor for whatever keeps people from living up to their fullest potential. The theme is open to interpretation by the artist, but all works should be appropriate for all audiences. The WCCAC reserves the right to refuse any submission.

All artwork must be original work. Artist cannot use images copyrighted by others.

Each artist must obtain a show number before the submission date. A show number can be obtained by sending an email to [wccacinfo@wilcocac.org](mailto:wccacinfo@wilcocac.org). The email should contain the artist's full name, age, and medium of their art.

While the WCCAC will do everything possible to protect artwork submitted, we cannot be held responsible for any damage to submissions.

- All flat submissions should be between 8" X 10" and 24"X 30".
- All sculptures or 3-dimensional artwork should be able to rest on a standard tabletop with a footprint no larger than 20" X 20."
- The contest is open to individuals of Williamson County, 8 years old and older.
- Artwork must be submitted between 12:00 and 2:00 PM on Saturday, December 2, 2017.

Please provide the following information with each submission:

1. Full Name of Artist
2. Age of Artist
3. Title of work
4. Medium used (optional)
5. Description of work (optional)

Artists will complete a release of information form, allowing Williamson County Children's Advocacy Center to photograph their art for use in publications. Winners will be featured in a 2018 calendar.
