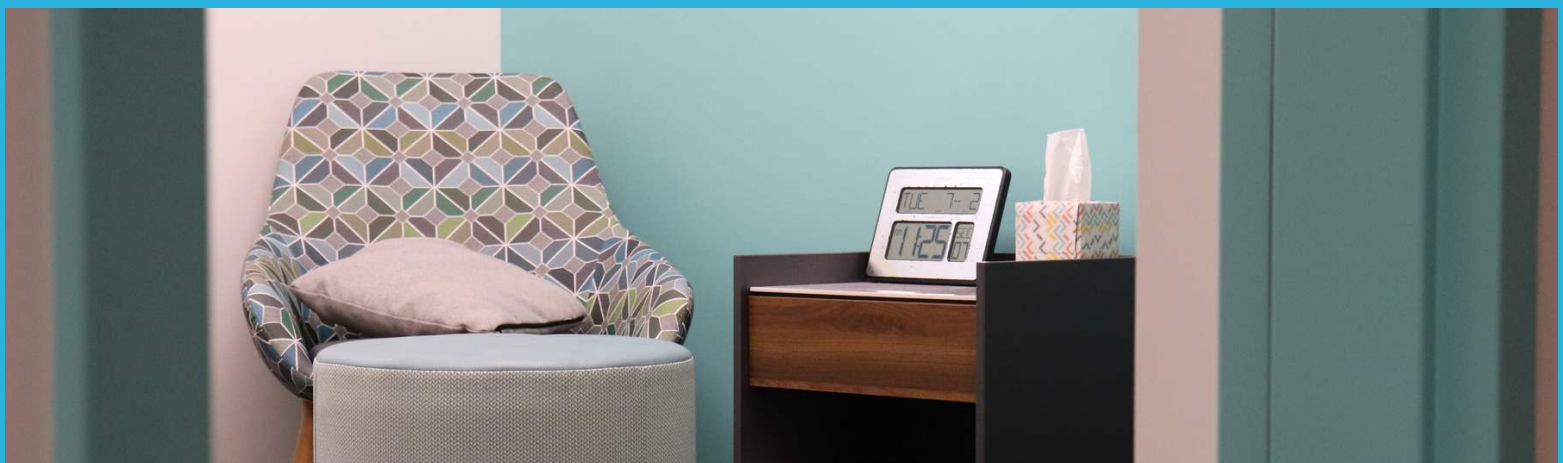

Each table will include a member of WCCAC's multidisciplinary team, providing guests with firsthand insight into the collaborative work that creates hope, healing, and justice for children throughout Williamson County.

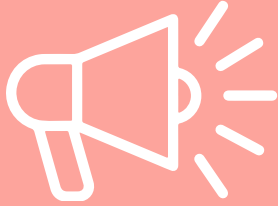
